Womenade Boston Seeks to Invest up to \$100,000 in Programs Serving Teen Girls and Women

Boston, Massachusetts--January 2, 2013--

Womenade Boston, the women's collective giving organization, will award up to 4 grants, each in the amount of \$20,000+ in June 2013. Womenade Boston is seeking grant proposals from non-profits working in one of 2 focus areas: 1) organizations that empower teen girls ages 12-21 and 2) organizations that empower women-ages 22 and older. **Letters of Inquiry are due January 31, 2013.**

Womenade Boston, with 90 members and growing, is dedicated to philanthropic efforts that raise awareness and funds for programs that positively impact the lives of women and teen girls in the Boston area. The organization provides grants for programs, projects, infrastructure, and organizational capacity building.

Womenade Boston, established in 2011, is a women's collective giving organization that believes that exponential results can be achieved by applying significant pooled funds, rather than individual funds, toward pressing and unmet needs in the community. To date, the organization has put \$135,000 to work in the community through its funding of Boston non-profits. 100% of the annual member grant contribution (\$1,000) is applied to grants. All women are welcome and are encouraged to join.

Past grant recipients include: Girls Leap, My Life My Choice at JRI, Science Club for Girls and Bird Street Community Center.
